Think about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Where the seeds need to be planted - When they need to be planted - What type of soil your plant prefers - What weather conditions your plant likes (sunny, sun / part-shade or shady) - What type of plant it is – evergreen or deciduous
