<u>English</u>

We will be starting our new Mystery Book this week, beginning to think about letter writing and how we can always ensure we are using our phonics, spelling and grammar correctly in our writing.



Phonics

Year I will be starting a new unit in Phase 5. Year 2 have finished their Phase 5 review, therefor we will now focus on using their phonics within their handwriting and English sessions. We will continue with review spellings, which we are taking from Little Wandle 'Year 2, Phase 5 Review Spellings'.



Handwriting

Year 2 will continue to work on their joins, letter orientation and ensuring we start to join all writing automatically. We will also link our handwriting with our spellings for the week. Year I will be working on their letter positions and keeping their writing on the line.

Maths

Year I

We are starting our new unit, Counting Within 20.

In this unit we will:

- I more and I less from a given number to 20
- Look at the number line to 20
- Use a number line to

- Compare numbers to
- Order numbers to 20

Year 2

We will be starting a new unit, Money.

In this unit we will:

- Count money using pence
- Count money using pounds (notes and coins)
- Count money mixing pounds and pence
- Choose notes and coins for a given amount
- Make the same amount using different coins and notes
- Compare amounts of money
- Calculate with money
- Make a pound
- Find change
- · Solve two-step money problems

Science

For science we have a new topic - Seasonal Changes. For our first week, we will be answering the Big Question - 'I love my new jumper, is it a good idea to wear it every day?' and dressing up Teddy for the right weather.

This term, our P.E unit will be Fitness. We will focus on agility, balance, speed, stamina and coordination.
