English

We will be finishing off our unit this week with writing our final persuasive letter, thinking about how we can use our language to persuade and convince somebody of something. Last week we wrote our drafts and this week we will need to remember all the useful information to include in our persuasive letters.

Phonics

Year 1 will continue their work on Phase 5 phonics and spellings. Year 2 will also continue with their spellings, working through some harder words. In class we will also focus on 'Prickly' words - words which are difficult to spell and which don't always follow the spelling rules.

Handwriting

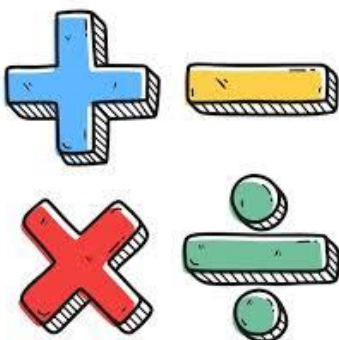
Year 2 will continue to work on their joins, letter orientation and ensuring we start to join all writing automatically. Year 2 writing is getting much better and much neater, please try to encourage joining as much as possible at home. Year 1 will work on their letter sizing and how we write our capitals larger than lower case letters, along with orientation of numbers - particular letters which are causing trouble at the moment are d, b, n, a, m, e, f, g and y - both capital and lower case.

Maths

Year 1

We will be continuing our unit, 'Addition and Subtraction within 20'.

In this unit we will:



- Add by counting on within 20
- Add ones using number bonds
- Find and make number bonds to 20
- Work on doubles and near doubles
- Subtract ones using number bonds
- Subtraction - counting back
- Subtraction - finding the difference Related facts
- Missing number problems

Year 2

We are continuing our unit 'Multiplication and Division'.

In this unit we will:

- Begin to recognise, make and add equal groups
- Introduce the multiplication symbol
- Work with multiplication sentences and arrays
- Make equal groups - grouping
- Make equal groups - sharing
- Work with the 2 times-table to then multiply and divide by 2
- Build on our doubling and halving
- Work with odd and even numbers
- The 10 times-table to then multiply and divide by 10
- The 5 times-table to multiply and divide by 5

Science

For science this week we will be looking back at what we have covered this term.

PE

For P.E this week we will play some of our favourite games and use our favourite skills used this term.

Topic

This week for Topic we will finish off our work on Space by commemorating the Moon landing. We will also finish and evaluate or moving picture books.
