<u>English</u>

We will be continuing our persuasive writing this week and finishing off our persuasive flyers. We then move on to letter writing and looking at the characteristics of informal letter writing.



Phonics

Year I will continue their work on Phase 5 phonics and spellings. Year 2 will also continue with their spellings, working through some harder words. In class we will also focus on 'Prickly' words - words which are difficult to spell and which don't always follow the spelling rules.

Handwriting


Year 2 will continue to work on their joins, letter orientation and ensuring we start to join all writing automatically. We will also focus on capital letters and their sizing comparison to lower case letters. We will also link our handwriting with our spellings for the week. Year I will work on their letter sizing and how we write our capitals larger than lower case letters.

Maths

Year I

We will be moving on to our new unit, 'Addition and Subtraction within 20'.

In this unit we will:



- Add by counting on within 20
- Add ones using number bonds
- Find and make number bonds to 20
- Work on doubles and near doubles
- Subtract ones using number bonds
- Subtraction counting back
- Subtraction finding the difference Related facts
- Missing number problems

Year 2

The children were finding our unit of 'Money' very tricky, so we have decided to work through multiplications and divisions (which are a great

building block for money work) first and revisit money later on in the term.

In this unit we will:

- Begin to recognise, make and add equal groups.
- Introduce the multiplication symbol
- Work with multiplication sentences and arrays
- Make equal groups grouping
- Make equal groups sharing
- Work with the 2 times-table to then multiply and divide by 2
- · Build on our doubling and halving
- · Work with odd and even numbers
- The 10 times-table to then multiply and divide by 10
- The 5 times-table to multiply and divide by 5

<u>Science</u>

For science this week we will thinking about the length of the day and how the days change with the seasons and why - why do we have darker evenings and mornings in the winter?



PE

This term, our P.E unit will be Fitness. We will focus on agility, balance, speed, stamina and coordination.

Topic

This week for Topic we will be learning about what the NASA team did on the moon. We will also be designing our own moving picture books.

RE

This week we will continue learning about Judaism, talking about the Torah and special Jewish celebrations.
