<u>English</u>

Year I will work on their letter sizing and how we write our capitals larger than lower case letters, along with orientation of numbers - particular letters which are causing trouble at the moment are d, b, n, a, m, e, f, g and y - both capital and lower case.

Maths

Year 1

- Measure in metres

- Order lengths and heights
- Four operations with lengths and heights
