<u>English</u>

This week, we will continue to work on our Mystery Book. We will be having a very spring based week - making fact files on flowers and bees, and thinking about maps. If you have any paper



maps which you would like to either donate or loan, please let us know.

Phonics

Year I now have 10 spellings each week. So far this has been really positive, so keep up the good work! Continue practicing these at home and don't worry if your child finds them hard - if this I the case, choose 5 to focus on and let us know. Year 2 will also continue with their spellings, working through the Little Wandle spellings scheme.

Handwriting

Year 2 will continue to work on their joins, letter orientation and ensuring we start to join all writing automatically. Year 2 writing is getting much better and much neater, please try to encourage joining as much as possible at home. Year I will work on their letter sizing and how we write our capitals larger than lower case letters, along with orientation of numbers - particular letters which are causing trouble at the moment are d, b, n, a, m, e, f, g and y - both capital and lower case.

Maths

Year 1

We will be working on their new unit, 'Length and Measure'.

In this unit we will cover:

- Comparing lengths and heights
- Measuring length using objects
- Measure length in and introducing centimetres

Year 2

We are starting our new unit, 'Mass, Volume and Capacity'.

In this unit we will:

- Compare mass
- Measure in grams

- Measure in kilograms
- Work on operations with mass
- Compare volume and capacity
- Measure in millilitres
- Measure in litres
- Work on operations with volume and capacity

Science

We will be continuing our unit, 'Changing Materials', looking at what makes something waterproof and what we can use waterproof materials for, such as building a house/roof.

PE

This term we will be focussing on Games. Later in the Spring we will have our inter school football tournament, so lets get working on those ball skills! We have a football tournament coming up after Easter, so we'll be trying to get some extra football practice in too.

Topic

We will be continuing our topic for this term - Ocean and Continents. We will be looking the oceans and their characteristics across the globe.

RE

We will continue learning about Judaism, focussing on Synagogues and what happens at a Synagogue. We have our trip to the Synagogue this Wednesday, which we are all excited for.
