## English

Year 2 will continue to work on their joins, letter orientation and ensuring we start to join all writing automatically. We will also link our handwriting with our spellings for the week. Year 1 will continue to work on capital letter formation.

## Maths

### Year 1

Maths, Addition and Subtraction.

In this unit we will be learning about:

- Parts and wholes and learn how to use part-whole models
- Fact families - addition facts
- Systematic number bonds within 10
- Addition - add together
- Addition problems
- Subtraction - find a part
- Subtraction - take away/cross out (How many left?)
- Subtraction on a number line
- Adding or subtracting 1 or 2

### Year 2

Maths, Addition and Subtraction.

In this unit we will:

- Recap on our number bonds to 10
- Fact families - addition and subtraction bonds within 20
- Bonds to 100 (tens)
- Add and subtract 1s
- Add by making 10
- Add three 1-digit numbers
- Add to the next 10
- Subtract across 10
- Subtract a 1-digit number from a 2-digit number (across and not across a 10)
- Add two 2-digit numbers (across a 10)
- Subtract two 2-digit numbers (across and not across a 10)
- Compare number sentences and work on missing number problems

### Science

For science we will be looking at what can impact and change a habitat and how this affects the natural life in that habitat.

### PE

Ball Skills will be our new focus for P.E this term, working on our basic ball control with various games and activities using our feet. Get your football feet ready!

### Topic

We are continuing with our work on Constable and this week we will be painting our own pictures of the school playground in the style of Constable. We have had a great time looking at maps so far and this week we will create our own map symbols.

### RE

In our RE this week we will talk about why Christians worship and the key characteristics of Christian worship.
