## English

## Maths

### Year 1

We are moving on to our new unit, 'Shapes'.

In this unit we will be:

- Recognising and naming 2-D shapes
- Sorting 2-D shapes
- Making patterns with 2-D and 3-D shapes

### Year 2

We are moving on to our new unit, 'Shapes'.

In this unit we will:

- Build on our recognition of 2-D and 3-D shapes
- Count sides and vertices on 2-D shapes
- Draw 2-D shapes
- Look at lines of symmetry on shapes
- Use lines of symmetry to complete shapes

- Sort 2-D shapes
- Count faces and edges and vertices on 3-D shapes
- Sort 3-D shapes
- Make patterns with 2-D and 3-D shapes

### Science

For Science we will be looking at minibeasts and micro habitats. We will collect information and data on micro habitats in our Forest School area.

We will be using magnifying glasses to take a closer look at the minibeasts.



### PE

Ball Skills will be our focus for P.E this term, working on our basic ball control with various games and activities using our feet. Get your football feet ready!



### Topic

For Topic we will be going on a local field walk to collect data on our local area, then use our findings to discuss how we could improve the safety in our area and the local playground.

### RE
